Taking turns is a way for friends to share toys and activities.



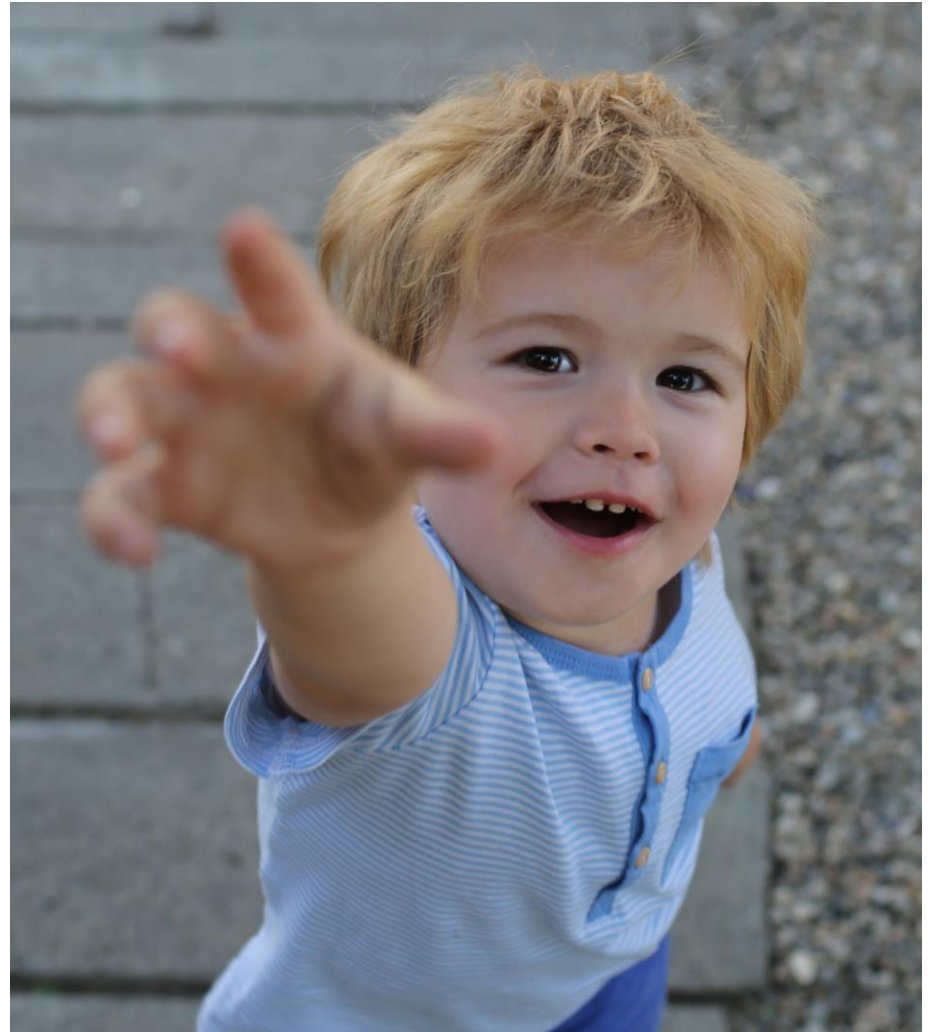
My friend can take a turn, then I can take a turn.
